ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION IN THE 2009/10 MANAGEMENT PLAN - WALLAROO

ISSUES RAISED 2009 MEETING	
1	Request for 5 year staged road plan for upgrade of Spring Range Road (use rates raised)
2	Investigate dead trees on Wallaroo Road – just before Southwell Road
3	Request for illegal dumping sign to be placed near ACT/NSW border
4	Request to abolish tip fee at Murrumbateman
5	Investigate difference in tip fees between ACT and Murrumbateman
6	Road safety concerns regarding organised groups of cyclists using Nanima & Wallaroo Roads
7	Timeline for provision of community noticeboards – (target April 2009 completion)
8	YVC website – system seems erratic for subscribers regarding information received
9	Community Consultation Meetings – difficult to find on website (provide link under villages)
10	Nanima Road safety - investigate linemarking and removal of dips/bumps
11	Access to traffic count data – Provide information to Wallaroo Road to Residents Group; is it feasible to place on website ?
12	Communication to area still an issue – channel thru Wallaroo & Spring Range Residents Group

ISSUES RAISED 2009 MEETING

13	Note that Spring Range Landscape Guardians change of name to Mount Spring Association
14	Alternative road out of Wallaroo area – consider for long term strategic planning
15	Investigate roadside weed spraying schedule (incl Barton Highway)– African Love Grass, St John's Wort & Serrated Tussock
16	Weeds an issue on TSR at the corner Nanima Road & Barton Highway (contact RLPB)
17	Rochford Road – claim that YVC changed status of road from a private to public road
18	The time delay for incident response by Police is an issue. Investigate how response can be improved
19	Who is the appropriate contacts for various incidents/issues (eg snakes)? – provide information to Residents Group

Yass Valley Council will be visiting villages in the Local Government Area during February and March to determine issues that should be addressed in the Management Plan for 2009/2010 – 2011/2012.

After this initial community consultation, we will be drafting the Management Plan, seeking Council's approval on the 'Draft Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 and placing it on public exhibition for a period of 28 days (15 May 2009 – 12 June 2009). All residents of the Yass Valley LGA will still have the opportunity to comment on the Plan whilst it is on public exhibition.

The Final Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 will be presented to Council at its meeting to be held on 24 June 2009.
