## WOODFIRES

As Anzac Day approaches we start to think about the cold winter months ahead and review our current methods of heating. If wood is the method that you are considering then you will need to seek approval from Yass Valley Council.

To install a new or upgrade your existing wood heater, approval will be required from Council under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993 (NSW). An application form is available from our office or from our website. Lodgement of this application will cost approximately \$230.00.

With your application you will need to provide a plan of the building in which you intend to install the heater indicating the location of the heater, any doors, windows and walls. You will also need to lodge a copy of the manufacturer's installation details. Note that this includes second-hand heaters.

Processing of your application may take some time depending on the number of other applications that are currently being processed. It is wise to lodge your application well before the cool change, or make alternative, interim arrangements for heating while waiting for your approval.

Once an approval from Council has been obtained a licensed tradesperson must be engaged to install the heater and a Council building inspector will need to visit and inspect the installation for compliance. The heater must not be used until a Final Certificate has been issued. It is important to note that in the event of fire, non approved heater installations may void an insurance claim.

When purchasing your new or second hand wood heater check the compliance plate on the back to make sure that it meets the current Australian Standard (AS/NZ4013:1999). The guide "Selecting, installing and operating domestic solid fuel heaters" has been produced by the Department of Environment and Climate Change. This guide will assist you in selecting the most efficient wood heater for your needs while at the same protecting our environment.
